THROUGH A COLLABORATIVE PROCESS, THE U.S. SOCCER FOUNDATION PARTNERS WITH COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO IMPLEMENT *SOCCER FOR SUCCESS*. THIS PROCESS INCLUDES DEVELOPING A STRATEGIC PLAN, IMPLEMENTING THE PROGRAM, AND PROVIDING ONGOING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.

THE U.S. SOCCER FOUNDATION IS TYPICALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Providing curriculum (K-8th Grade)
- Training program administrators
- Facilitating coach-mentor training opportunities
- Providing access to low-cost equipment
- Providing access to low-cost background checks
- Providing ongoing program support
- Providing data collection mechanisms

COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS ARE TYPICALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Executing program curriculum 3 days per week, 10-12 weeks/season, 60-90 minutes/session
- Recruiting, training, and conducting background checks
- Providing equipment minimums to coaches and players
- Reporting agreed-upon data back to the Foundation
- Maintaining appropriate liability insurance
